

## FALL 2017 SEMESTER INTERNSHIP AVAILABLE

Lyons, New York: Liturgia

Rural & Migrant Ministry (RMM) is a non-profit, non-sectarian organization that works for the creation of a just, rural New York State through: Nurturing leadership; Standing with the disenfranchised, especially farmworkers and rural workers; Changing unjust systems and structures.

RMM, in partnership with farmworkers in Western New York, has developed the **Liturgia Rural Worker Education Center in Lyons, NY**. Liturgia means: "Honoring the public work of the People". The Center offers experiential leadership development programs as we stand with rural workers as they seek to improve working and living conditions.

This Fall, we are highlighting three different internship opportunities at Liturgia. We also welcome students with specific interests and skills to contact us to brainstorm potential new positions.

1. **Justice Organization of Youth (JOY) Interns:** Every week a group of local high school students who are children of farmworkers meet to discuss social justice issues pertinent to their lives and ways to make a change. They are a relatively new group, so interns (we need two) at this stage have the opportunity to watch as the young people create their group identity. In the Fall in addition to recruiting new members they will be finalizing a skit they are writing this summer using Theater of the Oppressed techniques, and will perform it. Interns help facilitate activities and provide transportation to members using RMM's van and vehicle policy. Interns must participate in RMM's van and child safety training prior to starting the internship.

Position requires:

- Availability Fridays 3:30-10:30pm (includes transportation)
- Passion to be an ally and learn popular education methods
- Knowledge of Spanish or Haitian Creole is preferential but not required
- Driver's license and vehicle to get to Lyons where can pick up van for student transport and where the program takes place.

2. **Public Relations and Development Intern:** This internship is ideal for college students who wish to see behind the scenes of a nonprofit, work from campus, and have a flexible schedule. Interns will help promote our October Sowing Seeds of Justice Symposium and Dinner in Rochester, including writing and sending press releases. The PR intern can also help us collect blog entries, and contribute to our twitter and facebook accounts. Finally, we hope the PR intern will help advertise RMM events on campus and strengthen the existing partnership.

Position requires:

- Availability during the day and willingness to be flexible with hours
- Strong communication skills
- Preferably experience with traditional or social media.

3. **Farmworker Solidarity Project Intern:** RMM has a long history of engaging college students in the Justice for Farmworkers Campaign through internships, campus events, alternative spring breaks, and partnerships on direct actions. Starting winter 2017/2018, we are launching a **new** initiative to increase our student support by creating a student led group to stand with farmworkers. While RMM completes its goal of nurturing young leaders, students will become seasoned advocates and organizers for the JFW campaign and all other future campaigns. The "FSP" intern for Fall 2017 will help us finalize our plan of action for the new project, implement a series of programs to recruit

more students, and be an early campus leader. We are seeking at least one intern in the Finger Lakes and at least one intern in Long Island (where we operate another worker education center) to collaborate on this project launch.

Position requires:

- Availability during the day and willingness to be flexible with hours
- Strong communication skills
- Drivers license preferential (though not required) to occasionally visit other colleges or our Lyons office
