Rural & Migrant Ministry (RMM) is a non-profit, non-sectarian organization that works for the creation of a just, rural New York State through:

- Nurturing leadership
- Standing with the disenfranchised, **especially farmworkers** and rural workers
- Changing unjust systems and structures

Students interning with RMM will be working closely with Angel Reyes, the Long Island Coordinator. Internship hours vary, but are typically 8 hour/week commitments. This fall we are offering a **virtual** internship.

Digital Communication and Web Development

Amandla is a fast-growing center in Riverhead, and as our mission grows in scope, we need to update our marketing materials and social media presence in order to better communicate our work and invite new people to join us. We are looking for an intern with experience in digital marketing, branding, and graphic design so that we can create a consolidated appearance and messaging for Amandla. We would like to revamp our social media strategy and create a cohesive media campaign this fall. In addition, we are in the midst of creating an ambitious bilingual website that will serve as a hub of information and organizing for farmworkers across the state. We are in special need of an intern with web development experience.

Given the scope of the work ahead, you do not need to be an expert at all of the projects we described above. We will construct a plan based on a couple of key goals coming out of our priorities, and which skills (design, social media, and/or web development) you have and wish to develop further. In the ideal circumstance, we will have multiple interns with complementary skills who can connect virtually and work as a team.

All positions require the following:

- Flexible availability*
- Passion to be an ally for justice
- Strong communication skills
- Knowledge of Spanish preferred

* We will have a conversation at the outset of the internship to discuss your availability. We will set a typical weekly schedule that may change in accordance to shifting program needs (though always within agreed upon parameters).
