The Long Island Coordinator is in charge of Rural & Migrant Ministry's emerging presence in Long Island. Working hand in hand with the Executive Director, The Long Island Coordinator is responsible for three primary areas:

- The further development of our Education Center in the eastern end of Long Island.
- The continued development of a network of faith and labor-based allies and donors throughout the Island, Brooklyn and Queens.
- The coordination of the Justice for Farmworkers Campaign on Long Island

Working hand in hand with the Executive Director, The position has several primary components:

1. **Development of our Rural Worker Education Center, a Center for both farmworker and farmworker ally Leadership Development.**

- Oversight of the staff at the Center
- Further development of the Programs and facilities of the Center

2. **Development of allies in the faith, labor, and university communities**

- Lead fundraiser on Long Island, working hand in hand with the Long Island Council of the Board of Directors and RMM's Development Coordinator
 - Through presentations and grant submissions related to Long Island
 - In the development of annual fundraising events
- Development of Leadership Development Education Programs for allies

3. **Coordination of the Justice for Farmworkers Legislative Campaign on Long Island**

- Working in collaboration with the overall State JFW Campaign Coordinator
 - Oversee advocacy campaign(s)
 - Develop educational programs, presentations, delegations etc. in congregations, and other organizations on Long Island
 - Collaboration with other social justice and advocacy related organizations

Requirements of the position include:

- Experience in Popular Education and social change process
- Experience in Program Management
- Experience in Staff Management
- Bilingual in Spanish and English
- Strong experience and interest working with faith and labor communities
- Able to work irregular hours
- Work experience and a strong commitment to social change process
- Excellent interpersonal, networking, and organizing skills
- Self-motivated with excellent speaking skills
- A driver's license
