

MARCH FOR FARMWORKER JUSTICE

From May 15th to June 1st, we will march for 200 miles from Senate Majority Leader John Flanagan's office on Long Island to the New York State Senate in Albany.



Join the women and men who plant, tend and harvest your food as they seek greater self-determination and equality in the workplace. Farmworkers have been excluded from basic worker benefits, toiling under Jim Crow-era laws since the 1930s. Once again, we are called to advocate for justice and protect human rights by supporting the FARMWORKERS FAIR LABOR PRACTICES ACT (S1291/A4762).

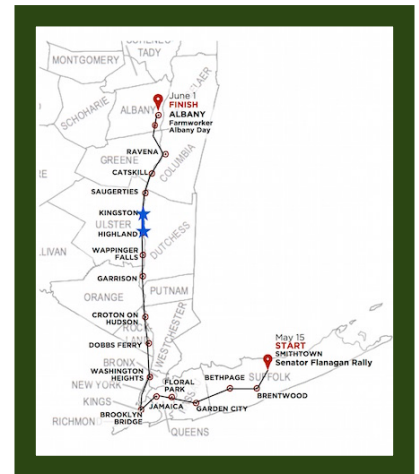
MARCH SEGMENT B: 11:15 AM- 12:00 PM – 2 miles
